1. The meeting was called in order and Dr. KG Raghu welcomed the Hon'ble members to the 11th Annual General Body meeting. He said that the Academy has made commendable progress during last few years due to the concerted efforts of the members. He complimented Prof. Abbas Ali Mahdi for organizing an excellent meeting.
2. The minutes of the 10th Annual Meeting of the Academy held on **11.09.2021 at 5.00 p.m., on online platform** were presented. Prof. Abbas Ali Mahdi proposed that they may be accepted and confirmed, his proposal was seconded by Prof. A.S. Bhatia and Prof. Alpana Sharma. The minutes were thereafter unanimously approved and confirmed by the members.
3. Prof. Hari Sharma, the Founder President, in his remarks appreciated the progress made by the Academy and expressed satisfaction with regard to the growth achieved during last few years.
4. Secretary General in his report briefed the Hon'ble members about the progress made by the academy during the year under report.
 - a) He informed the Hon'ble members that since last general body meeting, 20 (Twenty) new life members have joined the Academy. Now total life members are 335 (till date).
 - b) He also informed the Hon'ble members that in the current year under report quite a large number of applications were received for various Academy Awards. He further stated that as usual the applications were initially screened by a committee and thereafter processed by the award committee and the recommendations of the awards committee were

After detailed deliberations it was resolved that the Academy shall invest in Mutual Funds for extra benefits, whenever it shall be considerable for such investments. Further it was resolved that Dr. Abbas Ali Mahdi, Secretary General and Dr. Ranjana Singh, Treasurer, shall be jointly the authorized signatories on behalf of the Academy.
- d) Treasurer presented the financial statement and balance sheets of the Academy for the year 2021-2022. It was unanimously approved by the members.

6. At the end of the meeting Dr. KG Raghu handed over the charge of President IABS to Prof. Bipin M. Tiwale. Members congratulated Prof. Tiwale and put on record the services rendered by Dr. Raghu in promoting the Academy and for introducing large number of new Life Members of the Academy.
7. Prof. Tiwale assumed the charge as President, IABS and thanked the Hon'ble members for electing him President and sought cooperation from all to take the Academy to newer heights. Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
